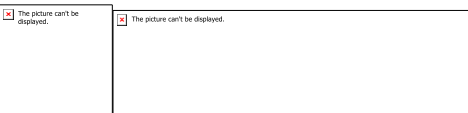


## Ratcliffe on the Wreake Newsletter May 2021
